# Steps in a Contextual Inquiry Session

Contextual inquiry is a user research method that mixes interviews with observations. They are an excellent way to gain insight into people's work processes, daily routines, how they use different products, and so on. Contextual inquiry sessions follow a clear structure. Here, we summarize the four steps of a contextual inquiry session.



## 1. Traditional Interview

- · Introduce yourself, your project, and the contextual inquiry method.
- Ask questions to get an overview of the activity you are studying



# 2. Switch to Contextual Interview

- Reset the roles to observation and discussion.
- Remember to introduce Master-Apprentice relationship

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# 3. Observe and Co-interpret

- Observe the user's activity while taking notes
- Ask clarifying questions about the users' activity



## 4. Wrap-up

- Share and discuss your overall interpretation of the user's activity
- Ask any follow-up questions you still have
- Thank the user

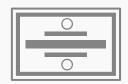
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
